

CONNECTING BUSINESSES WITH RESOURCES AND CAPITAL

With over 200 business on the corridor, Lower Goergia Avenue Main Street focused on leveraging the Main Street's capacity and resources for greater impact. Partnering with DC Bar Pro Bono's Commercial Lease Clinic, LEDC's Pro Biz Program, and a commercial real estate agent, LGAMS was able to specifically help 25 businesses renogiate and better understand their lease obligations. Additionally, LGAMS supported businesses in obtaining an additional \$1.7 million in relief funding from federal and local programs.
